From Midi/Zuid train station

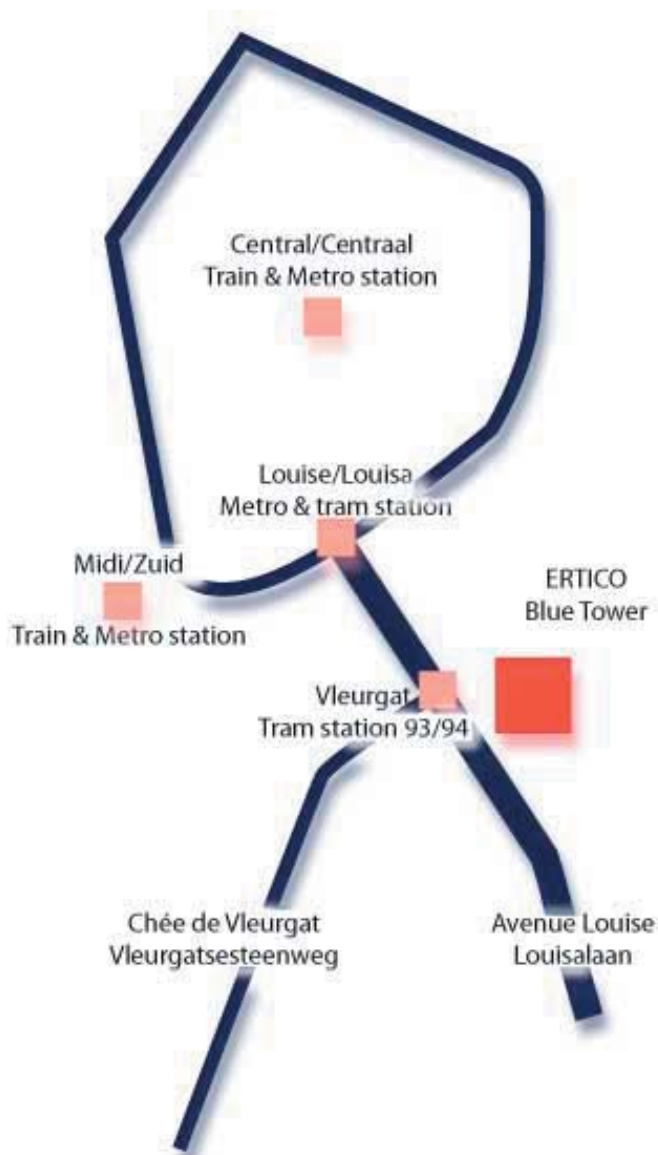
